Please note that registration for the general Vacation Program is not needed. The program is available daily from 8am to 6pm for all Primary Students. However, we recommend students to be on campus before 9.30 since a lot of activities begin at 10.00.

Open Offers, Workshops & Field Trip Information Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q) How do I register my child for fieldtrips and workshops?

A) To register your child for fieldtrips and workshops you need to log into your child's SOCS account, our Club Program Allocation Software. You have direct access to SOCS via the [BMS Primary Parent Portal](#). From your child's SOCS account please select your child's preference choices for fieldtrips or workshops. The selection period will be open for several days. Once the period is over, the SOCS software will allocate students for workshops and fieldtrips based on availability. The CCEP Office will notify you via email and hereafter you can see the activities your child has been allocated to on SOCS, see 'Activities'.

Please note: If you haven't received information regarding the BMS parent portal and how to access your single-sign-on credentials, please contact IT System Manager: Peter Wächtler, peter.waechtler@metropolitanschool.com

Q) How to select an activity (workshops and fieldtrips) preference?

- a. Go to activities.
- b. Choose your preferred day.
- c. Indicate a preference for each activity, with number 1 being your top preference. Important note: The software requires a waiting list, please rank it with the least preferred choice.
- d. Repeat this for all days your child wants to attend an activity.

Q) How many activities can I register my child for?

A) You can register your child for as many activities as you wish. However, SOCS software will distribute available spots for workshops and fieldtrips among all students who submitted preference choices, which will determine the number of activities your child can participate in.

Q) What about open offers?

A) You do not need to register your child for open offers using SOCS. Students can register for open offers on sign-up sheets when arriving in the morning. The sign-up sheets are posted on boards located by the main staircase on each floor.

Q) What if there are additional costs during the field trip or workshop?

A) Ideally, you submit the payment to a CCEP Educator or the CCEP Office days in advance or have your child bring it on the day of the workshop or fieldtrip. For field trips where using public transportation is needed, please make sure that your child brings a valid Berliner Schülerschein (Student ID) which allows your child to travel free of charge with public transportation. If your child does not have a Schülerschein on the day of the field trip, please make sure that your child brings money to cover for BVG tickets. Q) What should my child bring along?

A) A backpack, clothes for rainy or chilly weather when appropriate, sunscreen, a hat and of course, food and a filled water bottle!

Q) What if they are unable to attend?

A) Once you have received a notification that your child has been selected for either a workshop or field trip, attendance is mandatory. However, if your child is sick or cannot attend due to unavoidable circumstances, please notify us as soon as possible via email ccep.office@metropolitanschool.com
